This trip includes transportation by Cobb Motor Enterprises, two nights' accommodations at the Farmstead Inn & Convention Center, dinner and a play, *Dear Soldier Boy*, at the Blue Gate Theater, a "backroads" tour of Amish country with stops at Amish stores, a school, a buggy maker, a clock maker, businesses, and much more, dinner at Das Essenhaus, Indiana's largest restaurant, a meal in an Amish home, and, of course, an evening concert featuring the COLLINGSWORTH FAMILY with excellent seats on the left side of the stage so we can watch Kim Collingsworth's fingers fly across those keys, and driver gratuity.

The cost of the trip is \$400 per person based on 40 people; a single supplement is \$550. This is a slight increase from the projected price due to rising fuel costs. The trip can be paid in one, two, or three installments.

Lunch (on your own) at Coppes Commons, the former factory which made Hoosier Cabinets. *Please note:* most of the Amish stores, etc. take only cash or checks; no credit cards. Dinner at Das Essenhaus and then to The Blue Gate Convention Center to enjoy the talented Collingworth Family for a spectacular concert.

Saturday, August 13 – any "leftover" shopping in the stores right around our hotel or enjoy the morning at the hotel; lunch in an Amish home. Return to Michigan.
